- AQHA horse ownership is not required.

* Bling (n) - slang: You must follow AQHA Rule 445 on page 137 of the 2011 AQHA Handbook of Rules and Regulations for appropriate western, jumping and English attire. Nowhere in the AQHA rulebook does it specify how many pounds of silver must be on your saddle, how shiny said silver must be, number of sequins that must accompany your blouse or how many "X's" must be in the brim of your cowboy hat. So, don't worry about it. A lack or over abundance of bling will not affect your score or placing.

There are a few rules and eligibility requirements

- Competitors in Walk/Jog (trot) classes cannot enter in the corresponding Rookie or Novice class.
- Competitors may enter the rookie class if they've earned less than 10 AQHA points in that corresponding class.
 Note - when he/she is pointed out, they are no longer eligible for that rookie class.
- Competitors who've earned 0-25 AQHA lifetime points may compete in the corresponding rookie and novice class.
- Competitors showing in rookie classes will still earn AQHA novice points as defined in the 2011 rule book.
- When you first experience AQHA shows as a novice, we'll automatically enroll you in AQHA's Show Up! campaign, designed to reward you the more you show during your first calendar year in novice at AQHA Shows. Visit aqha.com for more information.
